

Greetings from the South!

Brethren and Sisters! I Hope that you and your Family are doing well, safe and healthy. "This Too Shall Pass"

Here's some INFO on how California plan to reopen, and hopefully we are part of the STAGE 3

We are now in early **Stage 2**, where retail (curbside and delivery only), related logistics and manufacturing, office workplaces, limited personal services, outdoor museums, child care, and <u>essential businesses</u> can open with modifications. The state is <u>issuing guidance</u> to help these workplaces reopen safely.

STAGE 2: Lower-risk workplaces

Gradually reopen retail (curbside only), child care, manufacturing & logistics. Later, relax retail restrictions, adapt & reopen schools, offices & limited hospitality, personal services.

STAGE 3: Higher-risk workplaces

Adapt and reopen movie theaters, religious services, & more personal & hospitality services. STAGE 4:

End of Stay Home Order

Reopen areas of highest risk: e.g. Concerts, conventions, sports arenas.

Stage 2 expansion will be phased in gradually. Some communities may move through Stage 2 faster if they are able to show greater progress. Counties that have met the readiness criteria and worked with the California Department of Public Health can open more workplaces as outlined on the County Variance page.

The issue had recently been resolved and the cards will be mailed.


