MASONIC EDUCATION

MFC participants have asked about the lodge charter. For our members information, here are several facts about our formation.

Columbia Brotherhood No. 370 had its beginning as Amity lodge, 117 years ago. Columbia Brotherhood became what it is now as the result of several lodge consolidations. The text of the original grand lodge charter or dispensation is shown below.

The Grand Lodge of California issued its Dispensation or Charter to assemble as a lodge of Free and Accepted Masons on October 12, 1905, for the purposes therein expressed. Our Lodge just celebrated the 117th year on October 12.

For those interested in such things, an excerpt of the charter are as follows:

Whereas, It having been duly represented unto us that sundry Brethren of the Most Ancient and Honorable Fraternity of Free and Accepted Masons residing at or near the City of San Francisco, in the County of San Francisco, within our Jurisdiction, have heretofore, are on the 4th day of June, A. L. 5905 received from our Most Worshipful Grand Master a Dispensation to assemble as a lodge of Free and Accepted Masons for the purposes therein expressed;

And Whereas, It having been further represented that the said Brethren are now desirous that their Lodge shall be duly chartered, constituted, and numbered upon our Registry as a regular Lodge, and it appearing, after due Examination, that they are Well Qualified and in all respects Worthy to assume and fulfill thee duties consequent upon the indulgence of and beneficent purposes of our Ancient Craft be promoted by the Constitution and permanent establishment of their said Lodge:

Now, Therefore, Know ye, that we the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons of the State of California, have authorized, constituted, and appointed, and, by this Our Warrant and Charter, do hereby authorize, constitute and appoint our trusty and well-beloved Brethren, Richard Cain, Master, William Jay Loveland, Senior Warden, and Edward Stephenson, Junior Warden together with all such other true and lawful Brethren as have already been, or may hereafter be admitted to associate with them, so assemble and work as a regular Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons at the City of San Francisco, aforesaid, by the name and designation of AMITY LODGE No. 370:

And We do hereby Grant and Commit unto the Master and Wardens aforesaid and their successors, and to the Brethren of the said Lodge, full power and authority to receive and enter Apprentices, pass Fellow Crafts, and raise Master Masons and admit Brethren to membership; to choose a Master and Wardens and other Officers, annually; to exact from their initiates and members such fees and dues as may be necessary for the maintenance of their Lodge, for the relief of poor and distressed Brethren and their widows and orphans, and for the regular payment of such Annual Contributions to the Grand Lodge as shall by it be directed; and, generally, to perform and do all their acts and things which shall be in full accordance with the Ancient Usage and Customs of the Craft, and in strict obedience to the Constitution, Regulations, and Edicts of this our Grand Lodge, aforesaid.

And We do hereby Require the said Lodge to attend the Grand Lodge t all its Communications, by its Master and Wardens or by its Representative, duly appointed; to keep a fair and faithful record of all its acts and proceedings which are proper to be written; and to lay the same before the Grand Lodge whenever it may be directed.

And lastly, We do hereby Enjoin upon the Master, Wardens, and Brethren of the Lodge aforesaid, that they ever observe a strict conformity to all the Ordinances of our Grand Lodge, which is the Supreme Masonic Power and Authority in the State of California; and that they constantly give due respect and obedience to the Grand Master and their other Superiors in office, in all things appertaining to our Ancient Craft.

Done in Grand Lodge, in accordance with its order, at the City of San Francisco, California, on this **twelfth day of October** Anno Domini **1905**, Anno Lucis, 5905.

In Testimony Whereof, We, Grand Master of Masons in the State of California, have hereunto set our hand, and have caused our Grand Secretary to make his attestation thereunto and to affix the Seal of Our Grand Lodge.



PROFICIENCY

Total Mitts given from 2009 to present: 52,438 or \$1,048,778.00.

AROUND THE LODGE

BOARD OF TRUSTEES REPORT:

During the Board of Trustees meeting on Monday, October 3, 2022 our advisors from Morgan Stanley provided an overview of the economy. It was duly noted that this year have yielded the worst return since 1928. Although some of the positions in our portfolio have yielded negative returns, year to date, and as of September 29, 2022, we are seeing a slow but steady improvement in the performance of our investments, and the numbers are up from last month.

Reports about the latest updates on market research were presented and reviewed. The trustees were advised of the following key points:

- * Continue to expect volatility over the next several quarters
- * Maintain long-term target allocation and maximum diversification
- * Refrain from making any big bullish or bearish bets
- * Focus on high-quality cashflow-generating companies
- * Fund any purchases by selling positions from within the same asset class

With these, the following recommendations were suggested by the advisors and approved by the Board of Trustees:

- * Buy American Electric Power and First Energy Corp
- * Sell a small portion of Apple and Microsoft and use proceeds to purchase Snowflake, Paypal, IBM, and Raytheon.
- * Invest a small amount of cash from the Life membership account to a 6 month treasury with a higher yield.

The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 31, 2022 at 6:30 pm.

TEMPLE BOARD REPORT:

The Temple Board met on September 6, 2022 at 7:00 pm. The following projects are currently being performed:

- ~ Emergency repairs were performed in the kitchen.
- ~ The air condition units are being repaired.
- $^{\sim}$ Quotes are being obtained for replacement of units in the dining hall area.
- ~ Internet is currently in the process and should be up by the time you read this
- ~ Camera scoping done on storm drain and no sign of damage to pipes

A motion was made to put in a new foam roof in the kitchen/ refreshment area since the AC units are being replaced. The motion was approved.

In addition to the November birthdays of our brothers in Columbia Brotherhood Lodge, No. 370, some other Masonic events which occurred in November are discussed below.

November 1, 1922, the cornerstone of the George Washington Masonic National Memorial, in Alexandria, Virginia, was laid in a Masonic ceremony.

November 6, 1876, the Order of the Eastern Star first General Grand Chapter formed in Indianapolis, Indiana.

November 21, 1838, the Grand Lodge of Arkansas was founded and formed.

November 22, 1991, Jerry Marsengill, a very active Freemason, editor of the Philalethes magazine, the Royal Arch Mason magazine, and Past President of the Philalethes Society was killed in an automobile accident.

November 25, 1813, the Articles of Union of the United Grand Lodge of England were signed.

November 26, 1737, a letter to the editor appeared in the New York Gazette newspaper, criticizing the secrecy of Freemasons and the words of the obligations' penalties (as disclosed in a previous expose of Freemasonry). This appears to have been the first antimasonic effort in the colonies that became the United States.

November 28, 1884, Quatuor Coronati Lodge No. 2076, in London, England, the first research lodge in the world, received its warrant.

November 28, 1911, Franklin D. Roosevelt, the 32nd US President (1933-1945) received his 3rd degree.


