

He then joined the Scottish Rite and completed its 32 degrees, affiliated with Island City Lodge No. 215 and served as a director on the board of its hall association and served as its Worshipful Master 12/15/2018 to 12/6/2019. He subsequently joined and was active in Asiya Shriners and the Holy Royal Arch and served as its Junior Deacon 12/8/16 – 11/5/19. He completed his earthly duties in a very short time. Although we will miss his presence in our lives, wish him peace and safe travels to that undiscovered country and send our condolences, and offer

our support to his family.

July 1, 1964, Rosco Pound was called from his earthly labors. He was a masonic scholar and the dean of the Harvard Law School. On this date in 1989, the Grand Lodge of Hawaii was orga-

nized. ¹


On July 2, 1908, Brother Thurgood Marshall (7/2/1908 – 1/24/1993) was born in Baltimore, MD. During his early career he served as a Civil Rights attorney during which he successfully argued several Civil Rights cases in the court system including Brown V. Board of Education. In 1940, he was one of the founders of the was a founder of NAACP Legal Defense and Education Fund. In 1961 he was appointed to the US Court of Appeals by President John F. Kennedy, and in 1967 he was appointed as the 96th associated justice to the US Supreme Court (1967 – 1991) by President Lyndon B. Johnson. He was a member of Coal Creek Lodge No. 88 of the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. ²



Robert Burns, Scottish Poet and lyricist (1/25/1759 – 7/21/1796), was initiated an Entered Apprentice on July 4, 1781, in Lodge St. David, Tarbolton. He was 23, and his initiation fee was 12 shillings 6 pence which was worth over \$580 in the year 2000. He was later passed to the degree of fellowcraft and raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason on October 1, 1781. One of his works of which many are aware is Auld Lang Syne ("old long since," "Old Times," or "the olden days.")



On July 4, 1776, the declaration of independence was drafted.¹

On July 6th, 1830, the Grand Lodge of Florida was formed.



**The Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of
Free & Accepted Masons of Florida**

"The first permanent Lodge in Florida was Jackson Lodge № 23 in Tallahassee, chartered by the Grand Lodge of Alabama in 1825. The Grand Lodge of Georgia chartered Washington Lodge № 1 at Quincy in 1828 and Harmony Lodge in Jackson County in 1829. These three lodges met on July 6, 1830, and formed the Grand Lodge of Florida, some 15 years before Florida joined the Union as the 27th state."⁴

The Grand Lodge of Connecticut was founded on July 8, 1789, with Pierpont Edwards as its first Grand Master. At the founding of the Grand Lodge of Connecticut, it had 14 lodges with five more being chartered in the following two years.⁵

On July 19, 1901, Sir Winston Churchill was passed to the Degree of fellowcraft in Studholme Lodge @1591 in London. Churchill was initiated into Studholme Lodge No. 1591 (now United Studholme Alliance Lodge) on 24 May 1901. Churchill completed his Second Degree nearly two months later on 19 July and was then made a Master Mason on 25 March 1902.⁶

on July 21, 1758, Fredericksburg, VA Lodge was granted a chartered by the Grand Lodge of Scotland. Degrees were conferred on George Washington in this lodge in 1752 and 1753.¹

On July 21, 1875, the Grand Lodge of South Dakota was formed.¹

On July 27, 1818, the Grand Lodge of Mississippi was formed.¹


