

JAMES GONZALEZ, MASTER

A MFC class was held on Monday, December 12 during which freemasonry and the first-degree symbols and the officers' installation were discussed.

In addition to the December birthdays of our brothers in Columbia Brotherhood Lodge, No. 370, some other Masonic events which occurred in December are discussed below:

**Brother William Fredrick "Buffalo Bill" Cody** (2/26/1846 – 1/10/1917) was an American Frontiersman and entertainer. He was initiated into the Platte Valley Lodge No. 32, North Platte, Nebraska on 3/5/1870, raised 4/2/1870, was a member of the York Rite, became aa Knights Templar (1889) and a 32nd degree Scottish Rite (1894), and was instrumental in founding Cody, Wyoming in 1896.

He was born near LeClaire, IA. At the age of 11, after his father was stabbed to death and after father was stabbed and died after giving an antislavery speech, he went to work riding up delivering messages for a and down a freight carrier's wagon train. At 14 years of age he went West and searched to search for gold, but met a pony express agent and took a job with the pony express.

Referring to the American Indian as America's former foe and present friend, he maintained that the Indian outbreaks of which he was aware were the result of broken promises and treaties. Cody was also a supporter of Woman's rights believed that they should do the work that they choose and should have been paid the same as a man if they did the job as well.

He was baptized into the Catholic church on the day he died (of kidney failure) in 1917 and was honored with a Masonic funeral.<sup>2</sup>

**Brother Carl Harry Claudy (1/13/1989 in Washington DC -5/27/1957)** was an avid photographer and American writer. In addition to photographing the Wright Flyer Army Trials which took place in 1909 at Ft. Meyer, VA; being a New-York-Herald aviation correspondent; and the director of publicity for the National Highway Association in 1911 and served as executive secretary for the Masonic Service Association (MSA) in 1929.

His written work consisted of stories for The American Boy magazine, a monthly children's magazine providing articles for boys between 1899 and 19414 and stories for DC comics in 1941, short talk bulletins for the MSA, and other books on Freemasonry with titles including: The Master's Book in 1935; The Lion's Paw; Washington's Home and Fraternal Life; The Unknown Mason; Introduction to Freemasonry Volumes 1 (Entered Apprentice), Volume 2 (Fellowcraft) and Volume 3 (Master Mason).

He was a master mason at Harmony Lodge No.17, Washington, D.C. was a 33° Scottish Rite Freemason, and was a member of the York Rite; served there as Worshipful Master of Harmony Lodge in 1932; and as the district of Columbia's Grand Lodge's Grand Master in 1943.<sup>3</sup>

The year 1901 was a busy year for **Brother Theodore Roosevelt (Our 26th US President).** He was initiated an Entered Apprentice mason on January 2, 1901 in Matinecock Lodge #806, Oyster Bay, New York.<sup>3</sup> On March 27th of the same year, and after being sworn in as Vice President of the United States, he was passed to the degree of Fellowcraft; on April 24th, he was raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason; and in September, after the assassination of President McKinley (also a Mason, raised May 3, 1865) <sup>3 · 5</sup>, he became our 26th President.<sup>4</sup>

As president he focused on conservation and the establishment of our national parks and national forests. His foreign policy included the commencement of construction of the Panama Canal.<sup>5</sup>

He is said to have said, "Freemasonry teaches not merely temperance, fortitude, prudence, justice, brotherly love, relief, and truth, but

liberty, equality, fraternity, and it denounces ignorance, superstition, bigotry, lust, tyranny, and despotism.<sup>6</sup>

On January 7, 1808, the Grand Lodge of Ohio was established. <sup>7</sup>

On January 7, 1785, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart received his second degree. <sup>7</sup>

On January 8, 1843 or 44 the Grand Lodge of Iowa was formed. <sup>7</sup>

On January 12, 1886 Quatuor Coronati Lodge #2076 was consecrated and constituted in London. It is considered by many to be the premiere masonic research lodge in the world. 7

On January 12th or 13th, 1818, the Grand Lodge of Indiana was formed. <sup>7</sup>

On January 16th, 17th , or 26th , 1865, the Grand Lodge of Nevada was formed. <sup>7</sup>

On January 17th 1872, the Grand Lodge of Utah was formed. <sup>7</sup>

On January 26th 1866, the Grand Lodge of Montana was formed. <sup>7</sup>

On January 26th 1887, Sir Arthur Conan Doyle received his 1st degree. <sup>7</sup>



## GOOD OF THE LODGE FRANCIS FELICIANO, SR., P.M.

### **SCAM ALERT!**

Many of our brothers have received "spoof" or "phishing" emails from perpetrators posing as one of our lodge officers or a member of the lodge. Some of our members have come very close to falling victim to these scams that often result in extortion.

The email appears to be a legitimate message from a brother and there is always some sense of urgency, i.e. out of the country and in great need of your help; a family member in grave situation and they need some monetary help immediately. Sometimes they will ask you to drive to the nearest department or grocery store to get them gift cards. They will add that they don't have access to a phone and they will have you respond via email or have you click on a link, etc. etc.

### DON'T RESPOND TO OR CLICK **ON THE LINK THEY PROVIDE**

Please do not fall for this scam. One way to find out if the sender is who he says he is, go

ahead and click the EMAIL **NAME** it came from.

If the email, for example came from GEORGE WASHINGTON, click on the name and see where the email address is coming from. If the address has a combination of letters and numbers that seems suspicious, for example:

### president-electt77@gmail.com Instead of:

Georgewashington@gmail.com

This is probably a fake email. If anything, do give the brother who allegedly sent the email a call. I guarantee that they will appreciate your call and confirm that they absolutely did not send you an absurd solicitation via email.

If you did however INADVERT-**ENTLY** respond and gave your personal information, or bought the gift cards, cease all communication with the perpetrator, block their emails and phone contacts and call your financial institutions right away so that

they can flag or close your account.

You should also change all of your passwords and monitor your accounts and definitely check your credit from time to time. You may also consider doing a FACTORY RESET on your device.

You may get annoying phone calls and they are now threatening to take out a warrant for your arrest, but don't be fooled. If anything, we have members in the lodge in law enforcement that can help. Please utilize their expertise and their knowledge.

There are other trickeries and shenanigans out there and they are getting very-very creative. Remember that their only goal is to get cash from you. If they can't make contact with you, they can't get paid.

Lodge Officers WILL NOT ask you for MONEY in private, unless your DUES are up!


