

Several of our past masters guided by our officers coach, WB Dionisio Dela Cruz, and WB George Wade gathered at our Lodge on May 24<sup>th</sup> to conduct the 2023 Past-Master's-Degree Conferral during which Brother Osama Muqatash was raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason.

### OUR YOUNGEST MASTER MASON

Brother Osama (Sam) J. Muqatash was born on June 1st, 1977, in Amman, Jordan and raised in family of 6. His father served as a judge for 30 years, and his mother was teacher. At the age of 16, he knew that his brother-in-law was a Freemason, and although he was too young to join Freema-

sony, he became fascinated with it and began educating himself about it. After graduating from high school, Brother Osama moved to Ukraine and earned his master's degree in biomedical engineering.

In 2007, after a few years working in his field in his native country of Jordan, Brother Osama immigrated to United States to fulfill his dreams including that of owning his own business. He immigrated to Los Angeles where he lived with his sister; he moved to Humboldt County for 2 years; he then moved to Novato; and he has lived in Millbrae for the past 11 years. Upon arriving in the United States, Brother Osama started managing restaurants where he learned food service. After moving to the Bay Area and in addition to his work managing a restaurant, he established a business with a friend, he became involved in Jordanian-American community, he was elected to and served for two years on the board of directors of the Jordanian-American association, and perhaps most importantly, he became a naturalized Citizen of the United States on March 21st, 2023.

In 2021, Brother Osama's cousin Brother **AZIZ YOUSEF**, a member of California Lodge No 1 and Columbia Brotherhood Lodge No 370, told Brother Osama that he was a Freemason, and Brother Osama asked him how he could join. Brother Osama first visited California Lodge No. 1 in October 2021, and at Brother Aziz's suggestion that he visit other lodges, Brother Osama visited Columbia Brotherhood Lodge No. 370 in February 2022. As a result of the friendship offered him by Brothers **JEFF MILLER** and **JIMMY FOWLER**, Brother Osama felt a chemistry of brotherly love and connection at Columbia Brotherhood Lodge No 370 and was initiated an Entered Apprentice Mason in our lodge on November 30, 2022; passed to the degree of Fellowcraft on February 28, 2023; and raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason by our Past-Masters-degree team on May 24, 2023.

Brother Osama considers himself a very social person who loves people and who makes new friends daily. He believes Freemasonry has taught him about brotherly love, and that he can have trustworthy relationships all around the world which is not something everyone can have. He reads about and learns more about Freemasonry every day as it inspires him to be a better person; and in addition to participating in concordant bodies like the Shriners, he hopes to work through the line and become a Worshipful Master of our lodge.
